### **OVERVIEW:**

### **ACTIVITIES**

1) HAVE STUDENTS WRITE DOWN THEIR TOP 5 FAVOURITE SONGS

ASK STUDENTS TO JUSTIFY WHY IT IS THEIR FAVOURITE

CONNECTION: OFTEN LIKE THINGS WE FEEL CONNECTED TO

ASK: WHAT DOES IMPLICIT AND EXPLICIT MEAN?

MODEL: PLAY "DOWN TO THE RIVER" BY BEN CAPLAN

AS IT PLAYS WRITE ON THE BOARD FEELINGS, KEY WORDS, AND CONNECTIONS

AFTER THE SONG IS FINISHED, LOOK AT THE NOTES AND USE THEM AS A BASIS TO MAKE AN INFERENCE. USE THE INFERENCING STEMS.
